NOTES / GENERAL

- All workmanship and materials shall be in accordance with BCL/NEC/SAFE STANDARDS - Latest Edition. The contractor shall keep a copy of the latest issue of this drawing on the site throughout the construction period.
- No growing media depths over prepared subgrade shall be:
Lawn areas: 80 mm
4th floor areas: 200 mm
Shrub areas: 400 mm
Tree sites: 800 mm ground root ball.
Growing media shall have physical and chemical properties as described in the Standards for Level 2 and Level 3 areas, except for areas over structures where the media shall conform to the requirements for Level 1 applications. Provisions and mixing of growing media components shall be done off-site using a mechanical screening process. Proposed growing media shall be tested by a recognized laboratory. The contractor shall guarantee that the soil obtained for testing is a representative sample taken from the soil that will be used at the site.
- On-site or imported soils shall satisfy the requirements of the Standards for growing media. Soils shall be visually free from rocks, coal, fuel, waste glass, paper, metal or reproductive parts of weeds, plant pathogens, organisms, toxic materials, disease over 50 mm and heavy objects.
- All planting beds shall measure min. 30 cm back width.
- Plant species and varieties may only be substituted without the approval of the Landscape Architect.
- The contractor shall guarantee all materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the date of Final Acceptance, unless otherwise specified. All plant material not surviving, or in poor condition during the guarantee period shall be replaced by the contractor at no extra cost to the Owner.
- The contractor shall clear away from the site all rubbish on it accumulation, and shall, at the completion of the work, leave the work and the site neat and in clean and presentable condition, free from all obstructions.
